The June 15th deadline is when applications must <u>arrive</u> in the State Office, not a postmark date.

Scholarship Requirements:

- 1. Must be a graduating senior of current year.
- 2. Must be currently enrolled in the 4-H Rodeo project in your county.
- 3. Must have completed at least two years in the 4-H Rodeo project, which included completion of project Record Books. Must show Record Book.
- 4. Must have actively competed in a minimum of three sanctioned 4-H rodeos per year for two separate years, one year being in the senior age group and entered in the State 4-H Rodeo finals that year.
- 5. Recipient must be enrolled as a full-time student in the college or vocational school of their choice in the fall semester following graduation and provide proof of registration to the State 4-H Rodeo Board Treasurer.
- 6. Applicant must not have reached their 20^{th} birthday prior to September 1 of the current year.
- 7. Amount of scholarship will depend on funds available.
