

FASHION REVUE CONTEST

I. Eligibility

- A. See General Rules for State Conference Participation Guidelines
- B. Must be enrolled in appropriate Senior Clothing Project
- C. Counties may enter three participants per category

II. Eligible projects

- A. Senior Clothing Construction I and II
- B. Clothing Self-Determined
- C. Serger Sewing – Fringed Skirt and Shawl or Advanced only
- D. Creative Touches

III. Procedure

- A. Garments are **due by the close of registration opening day of State Conference** – Late garments will not be accepted
- B. Garments must be accompanied by a 4-H Fashion Revue Information Sheet 200.C-4
- C. Garments must be clean, pressed, and covered with a plastic film cover. Hangers and bags may not be returned
- D. Garments may be entered even if they have been worn
- E. Winning County Garments may be entered even though they have been worn
- F. Garments will be modeled for the judges at the assigned contest time
- G. Judges will conduct a brief interview of each candidate
- H. All participants must model in the Fashion Revue Program to be eligible for awards
- I. **All Garments must meet current State and National Event Clothing Guidelines to be considered for awards. Failure to comply with Clothing Guidelines will result in disqualification.**
